THE SURPRISING EFFECTS OF UNDERPAINTING



In 2012, Sharon took the Richard McKinley workshop given by the Pastel Society of Central Florida. The textbook for the workshop was his book titled *Pastel Pointers, Top Secrets for Beautiful Pastel Paintings*. One of the chapters is devoted to underpainting, and McKinley prescribed 9 exercises that would provide years' worth of experience. These exercises involved copying a painting that she had completed. All 9 of the copy paintings were to be done on the same surface that was underpainted in 9 different ways. Sharon found the results to be very interesting and she wants to share what she learned from this exercise.



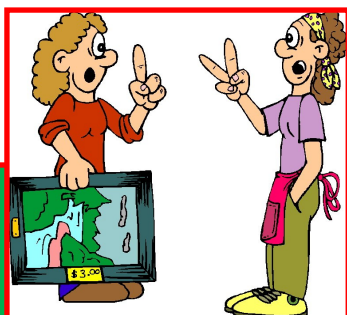
