# Qualifications for acceptance into the Fall Show at the Leesburg Public Library:

- \* Art must be <u>original work</u> and <u>created within the past three years</u> and never shown in an LAA show.
- \* Maximum framed width is 48". Any piece (other than pastels) larger than 24" x 30" must be covered by Plexiglas, not glass. Unframed canvas must be *gallery wrapped*; staples must NOT show.
- \* Painting must be properly wired for hanging. Frames, mats and glass/Plexiglas must be clean and in good condition. Artwork must be "suitable for family viewing."

### **Artist's Verification:**

I hereby agree to comply with the rules and regulations pertaining to LAA Member Shows as stated and clarified in the LAA newsletter, entry form, the LAA Yearbook & Membership Directory, and at the general meetings.
